For the 2018 ISBRA Congress, there will be an opportunity for several Junior Investigator Awards supported from the International Society for Biomedical Research on Alcoholism (ISBRA).

The Award includes a plaque and a check for \$1000 USD. The money must be used as travel support for the 2018 World Congress in Kyoto. Awards will be limited to young investigators (either PhD/MD students or young post-docs/physicians). PhD/MD student awardees will present a poster and post-doc awardees will give a brief oral presentation at the Young Investigator Symposium Lunch.

APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- 1) A copy of your original abstract – please indicate if you will be presenting a poster or an oral presentation.
- 2) A current CV and list of publications.
- 3) A letter from your mentor verifying that at the time of the meeting in September, you are a current graduate/medical student, or you will be less than 5 years post terminal degree for a PhD, MD, etc.

Deadline for the Junior Investigator Award application is May 31, 2018.
